5 - Food and Drink Policy

We work with many new materials with unknown long-term health effects.

Organic substances present significant contamination concerns for our devices.

1. No food is to be consumed in the lab
2. No drinks are to be placed on lab benches or work surfaces*.
3. If you find any food or drinks, please move them to the sink area and send an email to seabaugh.1@nd.edu.

*You may wish to have water or coffee when you are in a sustained period of testing. It is ok to bring a water bottle or coffee into B14, **HOWEVER**, it cannot be on a lab bench, computer desk, or sitting on or adjacent to any equipment or carts. Place your drinks in your backpack or computer bag. Then, **STEP OUTSIDE TO DRINK**, and return the drinks to your backpack or computer bag between uses. If the liquid is not in a thermos or bottle it is ok to place it temporarily on the bookshelf next to the door. Be sure to empty any containers and put them in the trash before you leave.
